As can <u>we be</u> seen from the maps, the area of the Islip town centre witnessed considerable willchange over plans for its development.

The road bisecting the area <u>was straightened</u> and on both sides various developments <u>took</u> place. On the north side <u>of the</u> countryside will be placed <u>a</u> shopping center, car park and bus station. They will remove the main road and replace it with <u>a</u> pedestrian <u>side walk</u>. On the south side of the road the main road will extend with new housing built. On the west side they will demolished the shops and <u>it</u> will be going to develop new housing. Also on the west side the shops will <u>be</u> replaced with new <u>a</u> bus station. The pedestrians were made to walk between the shops and bus station and car park.

In summary, the construction will mainly <u>be</u>made to facilitate <u>affairs</u> for the people who live in this town. Furthermore, roads have been made for walking as well as vehicles and the whole <del>contractions <u>constructions</u> seem <u>like to have has</u> been made with <del>a</del> good planning.</del>
