In this day and age the population is growing beyond our wildest imagination, so providing houses for this much bid a crowd is a matter of concern. There are two major solutions for this issue which this essay is going to focus on them. The more larger the population, the more homes are needed.

Many people opine that the price of a land in the countryside is lower than that in the city center. Therefore, one solution is to build houses in the countryside.
