Discuss both points of views and give your own opinion.

Every year various kinds of competitions take place all around the world, so a large number of people gather to participate in those. In spite of their merits which lead to people getting to know different cultures and places, some opine that these gatherings cause some troubles to <u>sports men</u> or even their fans.

Olympic game is the best example of these events. Not only are they people attend in it due to rivalry, but also they become familiar with other cultures which have a great influence on people's attitude toward other nations. Therefore, governments of host countries establish incentives, especially to their nations to persuade them to show their original cultures in a proper way.
