Many people leave their homes in the countryside to live in large cities.

What factors make people want to move to the city? How realistic is it to control the numbers of people moving to the city?

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Today, many citizens migrate from <u>the</u> countryside to settle in capital or large cities, the reason of this phenomenon is most of facilities ,work opportunities ,universities and shopping center congregate<u>s</u> in cities.

In conclusion, if <u>government have an</u> investment and <u>the</u> political will to improve facilities for older and <u>disable</u> people, extend the university and entertainment <u>place</u> and job opportunities for younger people, <u>this migration will be decrease</u> and most <u>of</u> citizens will <u>encourage</u> to live in their own cities, otherwise this is an evitable migration and it has bad consequences for the government.
