Hence, as is clear, individuals with diverse skills are <u>more better able to</u> flexibly develop their careers whereby having <u>a more better</u> chance to choose their career as <u>much as</u> possible.

To cut a long story short, although some people believe that individuals who focus on one skill are more successful in terms of concentration, people with various skills are more creative and productive person individuals and also they have more opportunity to find more jobs which will be more beneficial during their life.
