In some countries students spends about 5 hours a day in school, in other countries they study even less. Does short school day have more advantages or disadvantages? Discuss.

In some parts of the world pupils spend a particular amount of time in their school while in some other places people believe that students should not stay at schools for less than 5 hours a day.

On the other hand, there are some others who believe that not only <u>are</u> the current usual hours of educational centers for students <u>is</u> not enough, but <u>rather</u> <u>also</u> they are asking for more hours reasoning that due to the hectic pace of life and modernity parents are obliged to spend more and more time at work and therefore if the amount of time students spend at schools <u>is</u> reduce<u>ds</u>, they have to spend a lot of time alone at home, and this can lead to different kind<u>s</u> of unhealthy activities especially for adolescents.

To <u>make put</u> a long story short, I can say that regardless of the pros and cons of this controversial subject, my votes goes for longer hours of education at schools <u>be</u>cause I believe the benefits of such a system <u>are is</u> more than the losses.
