"Alternative Theater"

Augusto Boal was a Brazilian theater director, writer and politician. He was the founder of theater of the Oppressed. In this theater, the audience becomes active.

Body <u>does not is not serve</u> as a <u>symbol symble</u> of resistance, but also body is capable <u>of interacting to into act</u> with <u>the costume</u>, <u>dialoguegoe</u>, and <u>audienceance</u>. In alternative theater into action is extremely important. This is the view that Augusto Boal <u>emphasizes</u>, and his view was completely post-colonial." Spect-actor" is a term created by Augusto Boal to describe those engaged in forum theater. It refer to the dual role of those involved in the process as both spectator and actor. Dramatic text ,for him, is not <u>a fixed</u> entity. He directly <u>asks</u> the audience <u>to come</u> and <u>enter inter</u> to play and somehow to change.

To <u>some</u> up, He wants to eliminate any notions of the rolling class and the theater portraying their ideas. They think and act for themselves. Baol supports the idea that theater is not revolutionary itself but is rehearsal of revolution.
