At the present time, the population of some countries includes a relatively large number of young adults, compared with the number of older people.

## Do the advantages of this situation outweigh the disadvantages?

Thanks to the improvements in health condition all over the world, <u>the number of people</u> suffering from diseases resulting in fatality has decreased significantly over the past few years. Some of the Countries now enjoys a high young population rate, benefiting from this young generation to boost their economic and social conditions.
