Every day more and more buildings are pulled down and replaced with tall buildings. Is it a positive or negative development?

One of the most important discussions in urbanization is skyscrapers and tall buildings. Many of experts believe speeding up of the construction could have after_effects such as inbreeding traffic, destroying the environment and destruction of the urban texture.

When constructions aggregate in the area, accordingly more cars commute so it causes traffic jams. For instance towers which have <u>been</u> built in <u>the</u> west of Tehran, <u>have</u> blocked <u>the</u> air current approximately and that's one of <u>the</u> factors <u>in of</u> air pollution of Tehran. In addition, by immethodical constructions perhaps many trees have been cut down off and itwhich has dire consequences for our environment.

Finally high-rise buildings can have a negative effect on urban texture namely old and ancient buildings. For example, we can refer to Yazd city, which contains many monuments. If tall buildings were created in that region it could damage them and caused irreparable losses and that is because of the tall high buildings Loosen to soil region referenced.

In a nutshell, unconventional construction can have a direct impact on urban traffic, air pollution, and changes the in urban texture.
