Bringing in foreign workers to fill positions that domestic workers are unwilling to do can cause problems in the local community and should therefore be stopped.

to what extent do you agree with this?

Domestic laborers are usually reluctant to <u>do go</u> insignificant/<u>menial</u> work<sub>7</sub>; therefor<u>e</u>, those are occupied by foreigners, hence unemployment problems in such countries. For this reason, some believe that it should be restricted.

Although finding <u>a job</u> is important for each person, <u>but</u>-some people keep away from doing some kinds of work, especially both physical and difficult work with low/fewer income. Without <u>that doubt</u>, those <u>jobs are given to get with</u> strangers who leave their own country for finding <u>a job</u>. On the other hand, it may cause to serious problems and it also has negative side effects. For instance, it leads youth to unemployment.
