The role of education in our life is undeniable. That is why, individuals try to find the best way of outlining/ formulating a plan for schools <u>some of whom</u> assume that the government had better provide children with a co-education system. Some others, however, assert vice versa. I, personally, wholeheartedly agree with the first group.
